We have been working very hard to finish this project so that the student's can once again use Tumpinyeri as an outdoor classroom.

What has been done:

- ✓ Trees have been dead-wooded and trimmed to make them safe.
- ✓ Pathways have been widened and covered with chip bark.
- ✓ Weed eradication has taken place.
- ✓ The Learning Circle has been compacted with crushed granite.
- ✓ Signage has been installed to show the history of Tumpinyeri and many indigenous species of flora have been sign-posted as well as fauna habitats.
- ✓ The area has been fenced and an entrance sign erected.

We are very excited to once again be able to use this amazing resource located within our school grounds and look forward to Julian Leeser MP visiting NWPS to officially open Tumpinyeri.
